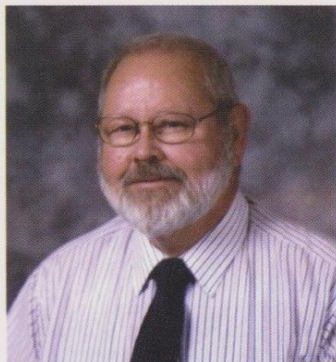


## SEMBLANZA DE JOHN D. MILLER

Primary research interest have been in sugarcane varietal improvements and associated research areas such as: cold tolerance, improved selection techniques, tolerance of sugarcane to high water tables, factores affecting seed set, photoperiod treatments to synchronize flowering of parental clones in the crossing program.

Dr. Miller has authored or coauthores 296 publications which includes the registration of 44 cultivars released in Florida, 4 cultivars released in Louisiana, and 3 cultivars released in Texas.
